This Centre helps Indigenous youths and families in need and shares Indigenous values and cultures on the Saguenay territory. Since 2018, Mr. Bacon has also given training on Indigenous realities and cultural safety in various public bodies, such as Health and Social Services and Education, to increase awareness of First Nations history and build trust between the various stakeholders and Indigenous people living in urban areas.
